California Community Colleges to Hold Los Angeles Town Hall Meeting on Recommendations to Improve Delivery of Workforce Education

Who/What: Members of the California Community Colleges Board of Governors and [Chancellor Brice W. Harris](#) will participate in a town hall meeting to discuss 25 recommendations developed by a task force aimed at improving the delivery of workforce education in the system's 113 community colleges. The [Task Force on Workforce, Job Creation and a Strong Economy](#) was formed to address California's anticipated shortage of 1 million skilled workers over the next decade. The panel's [recommendations](#) will be presented at the event sponsored by the Southern California Leadership Council and Los Angeles Trade Technical College, and media will have opportunities for one-on-one interviews with key leaders in this effort.
